Dear Saint John's,

Once again, we have volunteered to be a polling place for the 2024 General and Presidential Election. This not only provides a great service for the County and our community, but will also be a fundraiser for Saint John's, as the County will pay us a stipend and support for hours worked. As a policy, we have pledged to make all our labor volunteer, with the reimbursements and stipends provided by the County all going to Saint John's general fund.

We are looking for 5-8 more volunteers to help us. The more volunteers we get, the fewer hours each person will need to work. The County will provide mandatory training for volunteers on voting processes and procedures in late October, and we will supplement that with a brief review and refresher meeting at Saint John's on Sunday Nov. 3 (time TBD).

In September, Dress a Girl will be meeting on the second Saturday, September 14th from 9 am to 2 pm. We have some exciting news! We have been sought out by a ministry called Friends of Hope International in Florida, looking for dresses to take to the Dominican Republic. We have a request for 500 dresses! Because of our faithful servants in Dress a Girl from Southern California and on up the coast, as well as inland, we are able to fulfill this request! By the first part of September the dresses will be ontheir way to the Dominican Republic via Florida. Each dress goes with a personal hand-written prayer card to the girl receiving the dress. We've been told that the girls love these personalized notes! So - if you'd like to be a part of this ministry which offers so much gratification, please come to our workshop! Or call Pam at 805-710-7941. I can tell you, the "work" is fun and we know that wherever the dresses go, they are making someone happy! Additionally, the Dress a Girl label gives the girls protection again would-be human traffickers. How? The label shows the traffickers that this girl is part of a protected group. Not all of our ladies who sew for us, come to the workshops every month, but it's not a mistake that between our Central Coast Group and the ladies that sew for us farther south, we have approximately 100 ladies making dresses at home. If each one made just 5 dresses each in the next 2 months, we would reach our goal of 500 dresses easily. Can you help? Please, stop by on Sept. 14th to find out how you can help. You don't have to know how to sew, although it is an option that we offer to anyone interested. We have a need for 500 more dresses within the next two months, so if you have sewn for us before and would like to help out, please feel free to call me at 805-710-7941. We have dress kits ready to sew for that special little girl that God has chosen to receive the blessing of a new dress. If you can't stay for our workshop, you may take the dress kits home and sew them there - many of our sewists do just that! All finished dresses will be collected and boxed up to send to their next designated destination. If you sew with another group once or twice a month, maybe you would also like to sew with us.
